Item	Article	Proposed Change	Results
1	II: Membership	Establish RBT Member as its own membership class, increasing number of classes to 5 from 4. Fees would align with pricing for student members.	Passed, with 95% of the vote
2	II: Membership	Eliminate stipulation that membership year is the calendar year.	Passed with 92% of the vote
3	IV: Dues and Fees	Allow Affiliate Membership fees to be less than Full Membership fees	Passed with 95% of the vote
4	IV: Dues and Fees	Eliminate requirement of a full membership vote to set/adjust dues/fees	Passed with 68% of the vote
5	V: Officers and Governance	Add the position of Past-President as a non-voting board member.	Passed with 86% of the vote
6	V: Officers and Governance	Eliminate the requirement that President hold a PhD; President must meet requirements for full membership.	Passed with 86% of the vote
7	V: Officers and Governance	Establish provision allowing for the creation of an RBT Representative position, in future, in the event the RBT Member is established as a membership class and NABA has at least 30 RBT Members.	Passed with 94% of the vote

8	V: Officers and Governance	Remove "Program Chair" verbiage and requirements. (defunct position)	Passed with 89% of the vote
9	V: Officers and Governance	Update guidance in the event that a board seat is vacated before the end of their term.	Passed with 95% of the vote
10	V: Officers and Governance	Increase expense threshold requiring an official board vote from \$100 to \$200 and build in exceptions for recurring expenses required for the maintenance of the organization (ex. insurance, storage fees, email platform).	Passed with 83% of the vote
11	VI: Voting Rights and Elections	In ALL cases where a membership vote is required, allow an electronic voting option.	Passed with 97% of the vote
12	VI: Voting Rights and Elections	Regarding Board Elections: Allow call for nominations to extend beyond business meeting and inclusive of electronic communication.	Passed with 95% of the vote
13	VI: Voting Rights and Elections	Regarding Board Elections: Establish a minimum 4 week period between call for nominations and vote on board positions, during which time information about candidates will be disseminated to membership.	Passed with 98% of the vote
14	VI: Voting Rights and Elections	Regarding Board Elections: Require candidates for board positions to answer questions pertinent to the position for which they are running and have those answers disseminated to membership, at least 1 week prior to voting.	Passed with 97% of the vote
